



HANDOUT: CHILD RIGHTS IMPACT ASSESSMENT

The purpose of this activity is to assess the consequences of war, persecution, violence, poverty, and disasters on children and their rights.

Identify the Rights: List and identify the specific rights of children that may be affected by challenges faced by refugees. (e.g., right to a standard of living adequate for health and well-being, right to education, right to protection from violence or discrimination)

Analyze the Impact: how might each rights violation impact the child? Consider factors such as stability, health, education access, and overall well-being.

Consider Vulnerable Groups: Explore how the crisis disproportionately affects vulnerable groups of children, such as those with disabilities, unaccompanied, or those from marginalized communities.

Discuss the Long-term Consequences: Evaluate the long-term consequences of challenges faced by refugee children. Consider psychological, emotional, and physical well-being in the context of their journey and settlement.
